

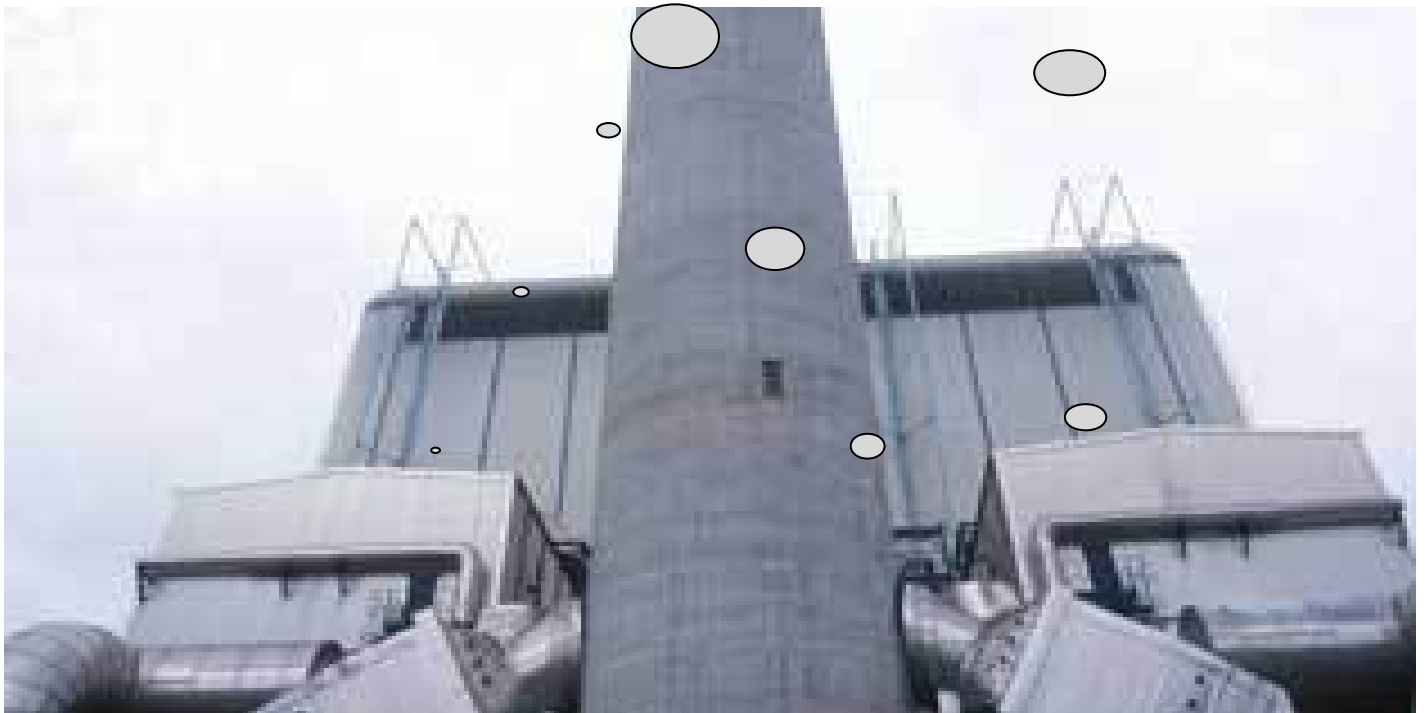

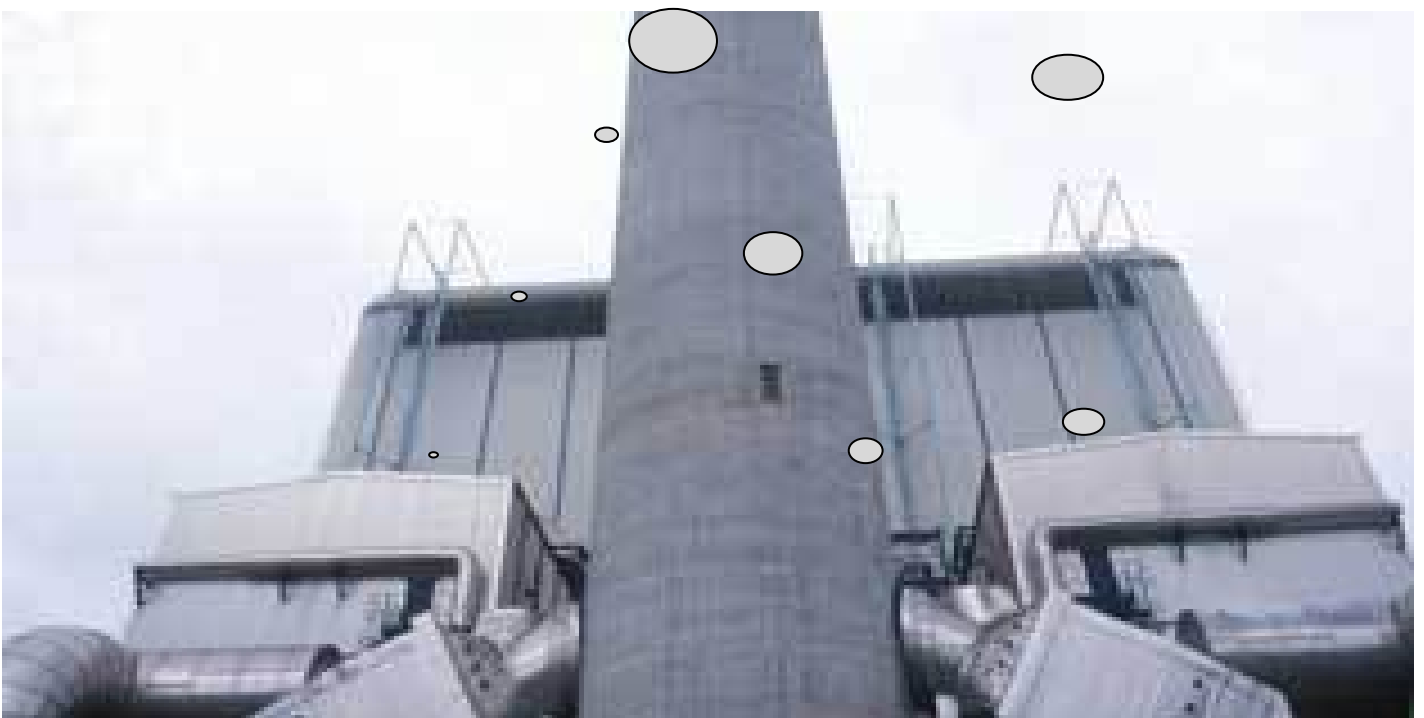

- **Oversized – burning waste from all over South Wales**

Long incinerator contracts for large amounts of waste have been shown to reduce recycling rates.

- **260 extra waste lorries per day on Cardiff's roads**

All through the day, increasing pollution and congestion.

- **Greenhouse gases, ultrafine particles & dioxins**

Incineration has the highest emissions of nearly all harmful substances compared with other waste management options.

- **Toxic waste – 120,000tonnes of waste ash per year**

One third of the waste will become ash. 17,500tonnes will be toxic and need special hazardous waste disposal.

- **NOT green energy**

Generating energy from burning waste is NOT efficient or renewable.

### **Alternatives**

- Waste should be dealt with locally using MBT (mechanical, biological treatments) which produces soil and reclaims recyclables.
- We need to maximise recycling and composting.
